



Camera Cleaning and Care





Essential Cleaning Tools

- Air Blower: Removes dust without touching surfaces (avoid compressed air).
- Microfiber Cloths: Safely wipes lenses and screens, removing oils.
- Lens Pen: Features a brush for dust and a special tip to remove fingerprints.
- Lens Cleaning Solution: Alcohol-free formulas are ideal for delicate coatings.
- Sensor Cleaning Swabs: Specific to APS-C or Full Frame



Cleaning Process (Lens and Body)

- Remove Dust: Use the blower on the camera body, lens surfaces, and crevices, especially before taking off the lens to avoid introducing dirt into the camera interior.
- Clean Exterior: Use a soft brush for dust and a damp cloth for grime.
- Clean Lens: Apply cleaning solution to the microfiber cloth, not directly to the lens, and gently wipe in a circular motion from the center outward.
- Lens Cap: Keep the cap on when not in use.



Camera Maintenance Tips

- ▶ **Keep it Covered:** Use a [protective case] and back screen protector.
- ▶ **Swap Lenses Face Down:** When changing lenses, hold the camera down to prevent dust from settling on the sensor.
- ▶ **Store Properly:** Keep cameras in a cool, dry place with silica gel packs to prevent mold.
- ▶ **Professional Cleaning:** For persistent sensor spots, use professional cleaning services, available at stores like [London Drugs]
